

You are cordially invited to the 36th Old Timer Fly-In at Schaffen airfield (EBDT). This event takes place from Friday, the 16th of August 2018 until Sunday evening, the 18th of August.

It will also be the 36th meeting, outside the Italian borders, of aircraft such as RONDONE, FALCO, NIBBIO, PICCHIO and SF260 designed by engineer Stelio FRATI.

Amateur-built and certain historic aircraft registered in European - Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC) member states no longer require- a permit to over fly Belgian territory for 30 days in a calendar year.

The airfield of Schaffen is situated on the northern side of the city of Diest (2NM) and west of the road Schaffen-Tessenderlo. For runway 06 circuits are left-handed and for runway 24 the circuits are right-handed.

We ask you to not perform any aerobatic manoeuvres and to comply with all aeronautical rules and regulations. In particular, please read carefully attached instructions and comply! Our Fly-In has been authorized under condition we strictly adhere to these rules.

During the weekend, each crew member benefits from :

- A free lunch + drink on the day of arrival
- Camping on the airfield close to your aircraft
- Transport to and from hotels
- A barbecue (€ 20,00 / pp) on Saturday evening followed by the Awards Ceremony with a Live Music Band and dance party.
- Awards categories will include best restoration, oldest aircraft participating, best Stampe, oldest pilot, youngest pilot, etc

On top, various Clubs of Classic and Vintage Cars will also be visiting the airfield.
